About this qualification

This qualification combines the specialist skills and knowledge and general work skills needed to be a competent locksmith.

Who this qualification is intended for

This qualification is for people working in the locksmithing industry.

Skills and knowledge covered

Core mechanical engineering skills including knowledge of materials, measurement, and using tools.

Core locksmithing skills and knowledge including:

- designing, installing and servicing a range of locking systems
- applying these skills to specialised locksmithing situations including motor vehicles and safes.

The qualification includes an elective section which lets learners develop general work skills. These skills include computing, communication, customer service and first aid.
